Application to the General Council of the Bar of Northern Ireland for a Temporary Practising Certificate

A temporary practising certificate, if granted, is valid for the duration of the case or group of cases in respect of which the certificate has been granted, or until its expiration on the Northern Ireland practising certificate renewal date of 30th April, as the practising year runs from 1st May to 30th April when, if the case or group of cases continue, the temporary practising certificate will require renewal.
